3. Exhibitors must have a copy of registration papers in hand. Non-Pros must have original papers.
4. Circuit champion awards will be given. Ribbons to six places for youth classes.
5. Class entries close when the previous class enters arena.
6. ** Classes have an optional jackpot.
7. Cattle classes not to start before 2:00 p.m.
